Sir,


We have learnt that the financials of Airports Authority of India are going in bad shape, not only due to pandemic but to the unscientific policy decisions, taken by Airports Authority of India under the external influence.

The handing over of six major airports of AAI was one among them. Though we did our best to expose the irregularities associated in the handing over process, right from the beginning of the inviting tenders, it is learnt that there was concentrated effort from every nook and corners to conceal the facts from the public, media and of course from the knowledge of Courts and other regulatory bodies.

We secured various documents through RTI and other ethical routes and it was undoubtedly proven that AAI entered into the contract without doing any homework, under the compulsion of Empowered Group of Secretaries, headed by CEO, Niti Aayog (Temporary Member) . It is also learnt from records that CEO, Niti Aayog's undue influence is apparent right from the selection of Airports to the wilful deviations from PPPAC guidelines, which was later on adversely reported by his own institution (Niti Aayog). The Research Team also analyzed the Concession Agreements and found that lot of uncertain and vague clauses were encrypted in the agreement, to get the tag of " Uncertain Contracts"u/s 29 of the Indian Contract Act, 1872, declaring the contract as Null and void.

We had compiled the irregularities and presented to Hon'ble Prime Minister of India in the form of booklet viz, "**Open Letter to Hon'ble Prime Minister of India**" for his active consideration. A Copy of the same is submitting herewith and request Hon'ble Chairman to review the contract and necessary remedial measures may be taken in order to safeguard the interest of Airports Authority of India. We further assure our best cooperation in this regard by providing clarifications and additional evidences, if require and we hope our findings will be honoured in right spirit.
