Sub.: Counting of service of newly recruited Jr. Asstt. (FS), from The date of reporting at training centres...reg.

Sir,

As per the terms & conditions for offer of appointment to the post of Jr. Executive (ATC), issued by AAI to the newly recruited incumbents, the date of joining at Civil Aviation Training College, Allahabad / other Centres, is treated as joining in duty for the purpose of drawing increments after completion of training and the service seniority for promotion to the higher grade is counted from the date of successful completion of training at the training centre (Allahabad / other centres).

But, in case of Jr. Assistant (FS) the policy is different. After successful completion of "Basic Fire Training" course at FTC, New Delhi or FSTC, Kolkata, the newly recruited incumbents are sent back to their home. Thereafter, the regional managements of AAI send them the offer of appointments at different times. As a result, in spite of successfully completing the training course in same date, their date of joining in service, for the purpose of increment and promotion, differs.

The above matter was already discussed in 2020 CJCM vide agenda point no. 3 and it was informed that the matter would be examined with GM (FS) & GM (HR)-Training. It is therefore requested that an indifferent policy, in this regard, may be adhered for both Jr. Executive (ATC) and Jr. Assistant (FS) cadres.
